AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE FEDERAL ROAD SAFETY COMMISSION COMMAND AND STAFF COLLEGE, IBADAN TO SERVE AS A HIGH LEVEL CENTER FOR TRAINING OF FEDERAL ROAD SAFETY CORPS PERSONNEL, PERSONNEL OF STRATEGIC SISTER AGENCIES, RELEVANT MINISTRIES, DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES AND AS A CENTRE OF RESEARCH IN ROAD TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATION AND SAFETY MANAGEMENT AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART I - ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FEDERAL ROAD SAFETY COMMISSION COMMAND AND STAFF COLLEGE 1.-(1) There is hereby established a body to be known as the 1 Establishment Federal Road Safety Commission Command and Staff College, Ibadan (in 2 of the Federal Road Safety this Act referred to as "the College") which shall have the functions assigned Commission 3 Command and Staff College 4 to it by this Act. 5 (2) The College-(a) shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession; 6 (b) shall have a common seal; and 7 (c) may sue or be sued in its corporate name. 8 2. There is established for the College a Governing Board to be 9 Establishment known as the Federal Road Safety Commission Command and Staff College and Membership 10 of the Governing Board of the Governing Board (in this Act referred to as "the Board") 11 College 12 3.-(1). Establishment, Membership, Objectives and College Management

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- 7.-(1) There is established for the College a body to be known as the 1 College Management (hereinafter referred to as "the College Management"). 2 3

  - (a) The Commandant who shall be the Chairman;
  - (b) The Deputy Commandant:
    - (c) The General Staff Officer I who shall serve as the Secretary.
- (3) The objectives of the College shall be: 7
  - (a) to serve as an international center to train management level officers of the Federal Road Safety Corps (in this Act referred to as:" the Corps"), Strategic Sister Agencies, relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies and as a Centre for Road Safety Research and Traffic Management;
  - (b) to develop the professional knowledge and understanding of the Corps personnel, Strategic Sister Agencies, relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies for training at the College in order to prepare and equip them for appointment to appropriate positions and promotions in the respective service to which they belong:
  - (c) to prepare and equip personnel of the Corps, strategic Sister Agencies, relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies for training at the College to function effectively, both in command and on general staff duties.
  - (4) For the purposes of carrying out the functions specified in subsection (1) of this section, the College shall have power to-
  - (a) conduct intermediate and Senior courses for operational level officers of the Corps, Strategic Sister Agencies, relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies with a view to expanding their knowledge of the operational and tactical frame work within which road traffic administration and safety management may be carried out;
  - (b) conduct short term courses for selected personnel of the Corps, strategic Sister Agencies, relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies with a view to expanding their knowledge of the operational and tactical frame work within which road traffic administration and safety management may be

19	8(1) The statutory functions, rights, interests, obligations and
20	liabilities of the College existing before the commencement of this Act under
21	any contract or instrument or in law or in equity apart from any contract or
22	instrument shall, by virtue of this Act, be deemed to have been assigned to and
23	vested in the College established by section 1 of this Act.
24	(2) Any such contract or instrument as mentioned in subsection (1) of
25	this section, shall be of the same force and effect against or in favor of the
26	College established by this Act and shall be enforceable as fully and effectively
27	as if instead of the College existing before the commencement of this Act, the
28	College established by this Act has been named therein or had been a party
29	thereto.
30	(3) The College established by this Act shall be subject to all the

obligations and liabilities to which the College existing before the commencement of this Act was subject to immediately before the commencement of this Act and all other persons shall have the same rights, powers and remedies against the College established by this Act as they had against the College existing before the commencement of this Act.

- (4) Any proceeding or cause of action pending or existing immediately before the commencement of this Act, by or against the College existing before the commencement of this Act in respect of any right, interest, obligation or liability of the College existing before the commencement of this Act may be continued or, as the case may be, commenced against the College established by this Act and any determination of a court of law, tribunal or other authority or person may be enforced by or against the College established by this Act to the same extent that such proceedings or cause of action or determination might have been continued, commenced or enforced by or against the College existing before the commencement of this Act.
- (5) All assets, funds, resources and other movable or immovable property which immediately before the commencement of this Act, were vested in the College existing before the Commencement of this Act shall by virtue of this Act and without further assurance, be vested in the College established by this Act.
- (6) Any person who immediately before the coming into force of this Act is the holder of any office in the College existing before the commencement of this Act shall on the commencement of this Act, continue in office and be deemed to have been appointed to his office by the College established by this Act unless the authority by which the person was appointed terminates the appointment.
- 9. The College shall establish and maintain a library comprising such books, records, reports and other publications as may be directed by the Board for the advancement of knowledge in the areas of work undertaken by

Power to accept 15.-(1) The College may accept any gift(s) of land, money, books, 25 gifts journals and other publications or other property upon such terms and 26 conditions, if any, as may be specified by the persons or organization making 27 28 the gift. (2) The College shall not accept any gift if the conditions attached by 29 the person or organization making the gift to the acceptance thereof, are . 30

inconsistent with the aims and objectives of the College or its position as a non-partisan institution free from any undue external influence. 16.-(1) The Board may, with the consent or in accordance with any general authority given by the President, borrow by way of loan or overdraft from any source any specified amount of money required by the College for meeting its obligations and discharging its functions under this Act so however that where the sum or the aggregate of the sums involved at anyone time does not exceed fifty million naira (N50,000,000) or its equivalent no such consent or authority shall be required. Borrowing

Annual estimates, accounts and audit

- 17.-(1) The Board shall cause to be prepared not later than 30 June in each year or as may be prescribed from time to time by Federal Government directive on submission of budget input by agencies and/or institutions of Federal Government, an estimate of the expenditure and income of the College during the next succeeding financial year and when prepared, they shall be submitted to the National Assembly for approval.
- (2) The Board shall cause to be kept proper accounts and proper records in relation thereto and when certified by the Board such accounts shall be audited as provided in subsection (3) of this section.
- (3) The accounts of the College shall be audited as soon as directed, or within six months after the end of each financial year by auditors appointed from the list of qualified auditors and in accordance with the guidelines supplied by the Auditor-General for the Federation by the Board.

SCHEDULE 1 Proceedings of the Board 2 1.-(1) Subject to this Act and to section 27 of the Interpretation Act 3 (which provides for the decisions of a statutory body to be taken by a majority 4 of the members of the body and for the persons presiding to have a second or 5 casting vote), the Board may make standing orders regulating the proceedings 6 of the Board or of any committee thereof. 7 (2) The quorum of the Board shall be the Chairman, the Secretary and 8 three other members, and the quorum of any committee of the Board shall be 9 determined by the Board. 10 2.-(1) The Board shall meet not less than two times in each year and 11 subject thereto, the Board shall meet whenever it is summoned by the 12 chairman, and if the chairman is required to do so by notice-given to him by not 13 less than three other members, he shall summon a meeting of the Board to be 14 held within seven days from the date on which the notice is given. 15 (2) At any meeting of the Board, the chairman shall preside but if he is 16 absent, the most senior member present at the meeting shall preside. 17 3. Where the Board wishes to obtain the advice of any person on any 18 particular matter, the Board may co-opt him as a member for such period as it 19 thinks fit, but a person who is a member by virtue of this sub-paragraph shall 20 not be entitled to vote at any meeting of the Board and shall not count towards a 21 22 quorum. 4.-(1) The Board may appoint one or more committees to carry out on 23 behalf of the Board, such of its functions as the Board may determine. 24 (2) A committee appointed under this paragraph shall consist of such 25 number of persons as may be determined by the Board and not more than one 26 third of those persons may be persons who are not members of the Board; a 27 person other than a member of the Board shall hold office on the committee in 28 accordance with the terms of the instrument of his appointment. 29

- (3) A decision of a committee of the Board shall be of no effect until 1 2 it is confirmed by the Board.
- 3 5. The fixing of the seal of the College shall be authenticated by the signature of the chairman or some other member authorized generally or 4 5 specially by the Board for that purpose.

#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to establish the Federal Road Safety Commission Command and Staff College, Ibadan to serve as a high level center for training of Federal Road Safety Corps personnel, personnel of Strategic Sister Agencies, relevant Ministries, Departments and Agencies and as a Centre of Research in Road Traffic Administration and Safety Management.

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
